Bake the jacket potatoes

- Preheat oven to **200°C/180°C fan-forced**.
- Cut each **potato** in half.
- Place **potato** halves on a lined oven tray. Drizzle with **olive oil**, season with **salt** and toss to coat.
- Arrange **potato** cut-side down, then bake until crisp and tender, **40-45 minutes**.



Finish the chili

- **SPICY!** The spice blend is hot, use less if you're sensitive to heat. Reduce the frying pan heat to medium-high. Add **garlic paste**, **tomato paste** and **Mexican Fiesta spice blend** and cook until fragrant **1-2 minutes**.
- Add the **water**, **vegetable stock powder** and **kidney beans** and cook until slightly thickened, **1-2 minutes**.

Custom Recipe: Drain the oil from the pan before adding garlic paste, tomato paste and Mexican Fiesta spice blend.



Get prepped

- Meanwhile, roughly chop **baby spinach leaves** and **tomato**.
- Grate the **carrot**.
- Drain and rinse **red kidney beans** (see **ingredients**).
- Heat a large frying pan over medium-high heat. Toast **flaked almonds**, tossing, until golden, **2-3 minutes**. Transfer to a bowl.



Make the salsa

- While the chili is cooking, combine **tomato**, **baby spinach** and a drizzle of **white wine vinegar** and **olive oil** in a medium bowl. Season. Toss to combine.



Start the chili

- When the potato has **10 minutes** cook time remaining, return the frying pan to high heat with a drizzle of **olive oil**.
- Cook **plant-based mince** and **carrot**, breaking up with a spoon, until just browned, **4-5 minutes**.

Custom Recipe: If you've swapped plant-based mince for beef mince, cook beef mince in the same way as above.



Serve up

- Divide jacket potatoes between plates. Top with Mexican plant-based mince and bean chili.
- Spoon over tomato salsa and drizzle over **plant-based mayo**.
- Sprinkle over toasted almonds to serve. Enjoy!
